- How could we reframe challenges to be seen as existing opportunities?
- How could we make sense of opportunities provided by the external forces & trends?
- What are the top 3 opportunities on which we could focus our efforts?

Aspirations Questions to Choose From

- What are we deeply passionate about?
- Reflecting on Strengths & Opportunities conversations, who are we, who could we become & where could we go in the future?
- What are our most compelling aspirations that pull us forward?
- What strategic initiatives like projects, programs, processes could support our aspirations?

Results Questions to Choose From

- What results from the last year really mattered?
- What results will matter most?
- What 3 5 indicators could create a scorecard that indicates progress toward the results we want?
